It's official: *La Collection* Loto-Québec is 30 years old! To recount the story of the artists and works that have made the Collection what it is today, *Espace Création* presents *Nomade, la Collection Loto-Québec en mouvement*.

Mark your calendars for a rendezvous with history, diversity, vitality and motion! Running from February 4 to May 3, 2009, the exhibit is structured around magnificent paintings, sculptures, glass works, prints, etchings, collages, gouache paintings, watercolours, pastels and charcoal drawings, each of which contributes to your collection, *La Collection Loto-Québec*.



Selected by artist and curator of the Collection, Louis Pelletier, the works are signed by Québec's renowned and emerging contemporary artists. Displayed in all their splendour, they will be rotated regularly throughout the exhibit. They will also take to the road as a travelling exhibit: in order to reach art lovers throughout the province, some fifty works will tour until 2010. Gatineau, Sept-Îles, Rivière-du-Loup, Val d'Or, Jonquière and Québec City eagerly await the Collection's arrival.

Witnessing *Nomade* is looking deep into the very heart of a one-of-a-kind collection. It's an opportunity to appreciate a wide assortment of works that have left their marks on the pages of time.
