



A Story of Passion
La Collection Loto-Québec
January 24 to March 18, 2007



To highlight the *Collection Loto-Québec's* 27 years of existence, *Espace Création* presents *A Story of Passion*. This event is a tribute to all the artists who have helped the *Collection* grow since its inception. Currently, it holds over 3,700 works by more than 950 artists from all over Québec.

Meticulously selected by curator Louis Pelletier, the exposition's thirty-eight pieces represent key moments in the *Collection's* history. Visitors will be able to view the very first work, obtained in 1979, as well Loto-Québec's most recent acquisition, a painting by Riopelle. Created between 1956 and today, each piece is a reminder of Québec's cultural heritage.

Set amid refined surroundings, the paintings, prints, sculptures and texts are juxtaposed with excerpts of testimonies by public figures and Loto-Québec employees.
