The *MÉTIER Réalisation* exhibition features:

**30 portraits of directors by photographer Bertrand Carrière.**

A selection of some 50 original personal items on loan from 19 Québec directors who participated in the project. Some of these items are related to the creative process, while others are souvenirs for which their owners have a special appreciation. The items include:

- a reproduction of an ink sketch by Victor Hugo
- a film can
- timeworn wooden yo-yos
- a marionette and frog
- some drawings etched on a table corner
- a notebook
- various reflections
- a film clapboard
- a megaphone

Screenings of:

- A selection of original conversations with directors filmed and directed by Bruno Carrière and projected on two screens.
- Trailers and film clips produced by directors who collaborated in the *MÉTIER Réalisation* project.
- A short presentation directed by Michel Poulette and produced exclusively for the exhibition, including a discussion by the director about the creative process and his vision of his craft.
- An animated short directed by Martine Chartrand and produced by the National Film Board (NFB) entitled, *Âme noire, un voyage au cœur de l'histoire des noirs*. Produced in 2000 and just under 10 minutes in length, this film was created using oil paint on a glass plate. Gliding like skaters on ice, fingers give rise to a little boy and his grandmother, who recounts the story of his past through his ancestors.
- An excerpt from the "Making Of" the animated film entitled, *Noël noël*, directed by Nicola Lemay and produced by the NFB. The magazine feature vividly describes the production's décor and various stages of its creation.
